Going Mobile with ABM

Being able to work effectively while out of the office, and allowing external programmes to communicate with ABM more easily, are a current focus of ABM. ABM has developed (and is continually updating) what they are calling ABM Flex (effectively an API) to allow mobile app developers to communicate more effectively with ABM. Some mobile apps that were reviewed at the conference were:

- Purchase orders
- Purchase requisitions
- Timesheets
- CRM
- Mobile sales
- ABM service (timesheets, product usage)
- Time and attendance
- Dashboards
- eForms
- Tracking and mapping

Capturing Document Data for ABM Xtracta

ABM are teaming with Xtracta to bring ABMXtracta. This is a web based service that will allow you to send a supplier invoice (or any type of document for that matter) and have it converted to data that will be fed into ABM.

As mentioned in the recent ABM newsletter, this will greatly reduce administration time and manual data entry. We are really excited by this upcoming option and are expecting ABMXtracta to be available in the first half of 2016.

Wages payment due	Payment will be made on:
25 th – 28 th December 2015	24 th December or earlier if required.
1 st – 4 th January 2016	31 st December or earlier if required.

This is really useful for monthly financial reports. Just minimise the report, process journals or other transactions and press the refresh button to update the report.
